Service Areas

Service Areas include groupings of service activities that are defined by particular client issues, disciplines and/or professional groups.

Agricultural Supports

Agricultural Environmental Services

Examples of agricultural environmental services include agricultural nonpoint source abatement and control programs, agricultural environmental management base funding programs, farmland protection planning, farmland protection implementation, and invasive species management.

Agricultural Economic Services

Examples of agricultural economic services include agriculture development programs, fresh connect farmers' markets, marketing programs, and specialty crops programs.

Agricultural Animal and Plant Health Services

Examples of agricultural animal and plant health services include animal disease control and plant disease control.

Environmental Supports

Natural Resources

Examples of natural resources include fish and wildlife programs, and land and forest programs.

Environmental Quality

Examples of environmental quality include remediation programs, materials management programs, water quality programs, air quality programs, and permitting programs.

Public Outreach and Education

Examples of public outreach and education include ecosystem management programs and environmental health programs.

Public Transportation Services

Public Transit-Capital

Public transit – capital programs include programs that work with rolling stock, transitway lines, station stops & terminals, support facilities and equipment, electrification power distribution, signal & communication, state or program administration, and transit enhancements.

Public Transit - Metropolitan Planning

Public transit - Metropolitan planning include programs that work with program support administration, general development/ comprehensive planning, long range transportation planning-system level, long range transportation planning-project level, short range transportation planning, transportation improvement program, planning emphasis area-coordination of non-emergency human services transportation, planning emphasis area-participation for transit operators in metropolitan & statewide planning, planning emphasis area-planning for transit systems management/operations to increase ridership, planning emphasis area-support transit capital investment decisions through effective systems planning, planning emphasis area-incorporating safety & security in transportation planning.

Public Transit - Rural Transit Assistance Program

Public transit - rural transit assistance programs include training, technical assistance, transit research, and related support services.

Public Transit - Management Training

Public transit-management training programs include travel, tuition/fees, and housing/meals.

Capital Rail

Capital rail includes programs that work with engineering & design, planning, construction, rehabilitation, and acquisition.

Capital Port

Capital port programs include programs dealing with engineering and design, planning, construction, rehabilitation, and acquisition.

Operating Rail/Port

Operating rail and port includes service/subsidy programs.

Federal Local Programs

Federal Local programs include programs dealing with highways, bridges, safety, preservation, transportation alternatives, and compliance.

State Local Programs

State Local programs include programs dealing with highways, bridges, safety, preservation, transportation alternatives, and compliance.

Aviation-Passenger

Aviation – Passenger programs include programs dealing with commercial service and general aviation.

Aviation-Freight

Aviation – Freight programs include programs dealing with cargo airports, air freight, mail, and small parcels.

Public Safety Supports

Evidence Collection

Evidence collection includes programs that work with sexual assault evidence collection kits, drug facilitated sexual assault kits, arrest offenders, and serving orders of protection.

Law Enforcement

Law enforcement programs include programs such as home visit programs, task forces/coalitions (e.g. OPDV program), and domestic violence courts/IDVC.

CBRNE Detection, Response, and Decontamination Capabilities

CBRNE detection, response, and decontamination capabilities programs include programs that deal with CBRNE detection, WMD/hazmat response and decontamination, explosive device response operations, and responder safety and health.

Critical Infrastructure and Key Resources (CIKR)

Critical infrastructure and key resources (CIKR) programs include programs that deal with critical infrastructure protection, risk management, information sharing and dissemination, information gathering and recognition of indicators and warnings, and emergency public safety and security response.

Information Sharing, Collaboration and Intelligence Analysis

Information sharing, collaboration and intelligence analysis programs include programs that deal with intelligence information sharing and dissemination, intelligence analysis and production, information gathering and recognition of indicators and warnings, and critical infrastructure protection.

Counterterrorism

Counterterrorism programs include counter-terror investigation and law enforcement programs, intelligence information sharing and dissemination programs, and explosive device response operations programs.

Incident Management and Response

Incident management and response programs include programs that deal with onsite incident management, emergency operations center management, critical resource logistics & distribution, and search and rescue.

Communications and Emergency Alerting

Communications and emergency alerting programs include programs dealing with communications, emergency public information and warning, and on-site incident management.

Emergency Planning, Citizen and Community Preparedness

Emergency planning, citizen and community preparedness programs include programs dealing with community preparedness and participation, citizen evacuation and shelter-in-place, mass care, and volunteer management and donations.

Regional Capabilities, Coordination and Mutual Aid

Regional capabilities, coordination and mutual aid programs include programs working with risk management, critical resource logistics and distribution, and mass care.

Health Emergency Preparedness

Health emergency preparedness programs include programs such as epidemiological surveillance and investigation programs, medical surge programs, medical supplies management and distribution programs, mass prophylaxis programs, emergency triage and pre-hospital treatment programs, and isolation and quarantine programs.

Cyber Security Preparedness

Cyber security preparedness programs include programs that deal with critical infrastructure protection, risk management, intelligence information sharing and dissemination, intelligence analysis and production, and information gathering and recognition of indicators and warnings.
